

Documentation for Aware Logs

The aware_log table logs the important status of the AWARE-Light application, user interaction with sensors and ESM scheduler triggers.

| Log message example | Explanation |
|---|--|
| "Aware-starting" | Logged when AWARE-Light is launched for the first time after installation or reopened following the last termination. |
| "phone: on" | Logged when the device finishes its boot process and is ready to be used. |
| "phone: off" | Logged when the device is in the process of shutting down. |
| "phone: reboot" | Logged when the device is in the process of rebooting or restarting. |
| <pre>"{"internet":true, "wifi":true, "bt":true, "network":true, "airplane":false, "roaming":false, "location_gps":true, "location_network":true}"</pre> | A JSON representation of compliance status values for various settings. Indications for each compliance status are as follows: • "internet" is reported as true indicating that the device has an active internet connection; false otherwise • "wifi" is reported as true indicating that the device is connected to a Wi-Fi network; false otherwise • "bt" (Bluetooth) is reported as true indicating that Bluetooth is available and can be used; false otherwise • "network" is reported as true indicating that the mobile network (cellular data) is available; false otherwise • "airplane" is reported as true indicating that airplane mode is enabled, which disables all wireless communication; false otherwise • "roaming" is reported as true indicating that the device is in roaming mode, indicating it's using a different carrier's network; false otherwise • "location_gps" is reported as true indicating that the GPS location provider is enabled and can |

| | provide accurate location data; false otherwise • "location_network" is reported as true indicating that the network-based location provider is enabled and can provide location data using Wi- Fi and mobile networks; false otherwise |

| "AWARE-Light interface cleaned from the array of frequently used apps" | The user manually removed AWARE-Light from the Overview (Recent Apps) interface. |
| "AWARE-Light interface cleaned by smartphone system" | AWARE-Light was removed from the Overview (Recent Apps) interface through system actions. |
| "AWARE-Light stopped from background: may caused by battery optimization" | AWARE-Light has been terminated from the background potentially due to battery optimization. |
| "AWARE-Light stopped from background: may caused by system settings" | AWARE-Light was terminated from the background due to system settings other than battery optimization. |
| "Failed to sync study, something is wrong with the config." | Data synchronization failed due to an unsuccessful database connection, as specified in the configurator. |
| "Updated study config: <new_study_config>"</new_study_config> | The study configurator has been updated, with a representation of the new study configurator information. |
| "Scheduler triggered: <schedule id=""> schedule: <schedule info=""> package: <package name="">"</package></schedule></schedule> | Logged when an ESM question is triggered, including specific information about the scheduler such as schedule ID, content and package name. |
| "Sensor: <sensor name="">=<true false="">"</true></sensor> | Logged when the user manually enables or disables a sensor for data collection. True indicates the sensor is on, false indicates it is off. |
| <pre>"{"table":, "last_sync_timestamp": <timestamp>}"</timestamp></pre> | A log of the most recent data synchronization timestamp |
| "STUDY-SYNC: " | A log indicating that the table has been successfully synchronized |
